### **IP addresses and cookies**

When you use our forums, we log the IP addresses and anonymous miscellaneous information such as your operating system and browser version. This information is used solely for administration, trouble-shooting and security purposes.

Don'tDumpThat uses cookies to help us improve our website and forums and provide a better service. Cookies allow us to find out if a computer (and probably its user) has visited our site before, which helps us to build up a profile of how our members use our website. Many websites use cookies for this reason.
